H.H. Perkins being first duly sworn deposes and says; that he is the Vice President of the Valley Lumber Company, a corporation; that the said corporation was originally incorporated under the laws of the State of Washington it having its principal place of business in the Town of Clarkston therein; that said company was engaged in a general lumbering business and while so conducting said business maintained a warehouse in the City of Lewiston, Idaho. That while so operating said warehouse aforesaid the said corporation filed copies of its articles of incorporation with the Secretary of State of Idaho and with the County Recorder of Nez Perce County and otherwise complied with the laws of the State of Idaho, relative to foreign corporations. That the said corporation ceased active business operations about $4\frac{1}{2}$ years ago and has not operated its warehouse in Lewiston or been engaged in business in the State of Idaho for a period of $1\frac{1}{3}$ years last past. That the said corporation is not at this time engaged in business in the State of Idaho.
