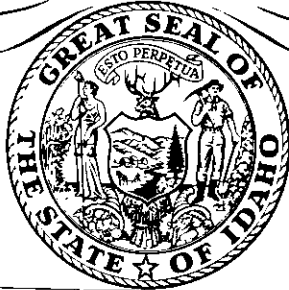

CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

GRAY LANDSCAPING, INC.

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **first** day of **May,** A.D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Fifty-Nine,** and duly recorded on Film No. **106** of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 30-103, Idaho Code.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Idaho Falls,** in the County of **Bonneville.**

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
GRAY LANDSCAPING, INC.

We, the undersigned, being natural persons of full age and citizens of the United States, hereby incorporate ourselves under the Business Corporations Act of the State of Idaho [§§30-101ff. I.C.].

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be Gray Landscaping, Inc.

ARTICLE II

The purposes of the corporation are to do any or all of the things herein mentioned, to the same extent as natural persons might, as follows:

- a. To purchase, acquire, hold, sell, exchange, raise, cultivate, or otherwise deal with or dispose of plants, trees, shrubs and other nursery products.
- b. To carry on a general excavation, earth-moving and contracting business and to that end to lease, own, acquire, deal in and dispose of tractors, trucks, automobiles, and other vehicles, and appliances and equipment.
- c. To enter into and perform contracts for the grading or paving of streets, driveways, highways, parking lots, and similar areas.
- d. To act as a general contractor for the construction, repairing and remodeling of buildings and public works of all kinds and for the improvement of real estate and the doing of any and all other business and contracting incidental thereto, or connected therewith.
- e. To manufacture and sell brick, and sewer or

tile pipe and to enter into contracts for the performance of any work or construction of any structure or improvement, in the doing or construction of which products of the character to be manufactured by this company are used, and to do such work and construct such structures and improvements.

f. To acquire in any lawful manner and to hold, develop, improve, subdivide, lease, construct, exchange, mortgage, sell, convey, finance, or otherwise dispose of or deal in, real estate.

g. To buy, sell and own stock in other corporations.

h. To borrow or raise money for any of the purposes of the corporation (without limit as to amount) and in connection therewith, to grant collateral or other security, either alone or jointly with any other person, firm or corporation and to make and issue promissory notes, drafts, bonds, debentures and other evidences of indebtedness; and to lend and advance money, extend credit, take notes, open accounts, and every kind of evidence of indebtedness and collateral security in connection therewith.

And in general, to do any and all things and exercise any and all powers which may now or hereafter be lawful for the corporation to do or exercise under and in pursuance of the Business Corporation Act of the state of Idaho, or of any other law that might be now or hereafter applicable to the corporation.

ARTICLE III

The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IV

The location and post office address of the registered office of the corporation shall be Idaho Falls, Idaho, but meetings

of the board of directors and of any executive committee thereof, may be held at such registered office or at such other place within or without this state for the transaction of any business of the corporation, as the directors may, by resolution or by-laws, provide.

ARTICLE V

The total authorized number of shares shall be 1000, with an aggregate par value of \$5000, such shares to be of the same class and of \$5 par value each.

ARTICLE VII

Subject to the power of the shareholders to make, amend, or repeal by-laws, the board of directors may amend or repeal them, or adopt new ones, provided, that by-laws made by the board of directors may be amended or repealed either by a two-thirds vote of the board of directors or by a vote of two-thirds of the allotted shares.
