ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
SEVERANCE FARM, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, each and all being natural persons of full age and citizens of the United States have this day and do hereby voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby certify:

-1-

The name of said corporation shall be Severance Farm, Inc.

-2-

The location and post office address of the registered office of the corporation is Hazelton, Idaho.

-3-

The corporation is to have perpetual existence.

-4-

The total amount of authorized capital stock is 2,500 shares of the par value of \$100.00 with an aggregate value of \$250,000.00. All such stock shall be common and non-assessable and each and every share issued shall have the same rights and voting powers.

-5-

The business of this corporation shall be managed by a board of at least three directors who need not be shareholders and provided, however, that any greater or lesser number of directors may be provided for by the By-Laws of said corporation.

-6-

The purposes for which said corporation is formed are as follows:

- (a) To purchase and sell farms and engage in the business of farming and producing, merchandising, and preserving all kinds of farm, fruit, vegetable and garden products and of cultivating, growing, harvesting, picking, cleaning and assorting, boxing, packing, shipping, buying and selling, at wholesale and retail all kinds of farm and garden products.
- (b) To breed, raise, import, export and deal in cattle and livestock of all kinds and to carry on a general cattle and grazing business, purchasing or acquiring and selling or otherwise disposing of the stock, supplies, equipment, accessories, appurtenances, products and by-products of said business.
- (c) To purchase, improve, develop, lease, exchange, sell, dispose of and otherwise deal in and turn to account real estate; to purchase, lease, build, construct, erect, occupy and manage buildings of every kind and character whatsoever; to finance the purchase, improvement, development and construction of lands and buildings belong to or to be acquired by this company or any other person, firm or corporation.
- (d) To purchase and acquire its own stock, as well as the stock in any other corporation whose stock is owned by the same or largely the same stockholders; and to do all manner of lawful business with other corporations, including corporations whose stock is owned by the same or largely the same stockholders.
- (e) To transact the business of investing on behalf of itself, or others, any part of its capital and such additional funds as it may obtain, or any interest therein, either as tenant in common or otherwise, and selling or otherwise disposing of the same, or any part thereof, or interest therein.
- (f) To buy, acquire, own, trade, pledge, and sell capital stock, bonds, debentures, or other securities issued by any other corporation, private, public or municipal or by any State or political subdivision of the United States.
- (g) To engage in any commercial, industrial and agricultural enterprise calculated or designed to be profitable to the corporation and in conformity with the laws of the State of Idaho.

To generally engage in, do and perform any enterprise, act or vocation that a natural person might or could do or perform.

To engage in the manufacture, sale, purchase, importing, and exporting of merchandise and personal property of all manner and description, to act as agents for the purchase, sale, and handling of goods, wares and merchandise of any and all types and descriptions for the account of the corporation or as factor, agent, procure or otherwise for or on behalf of another.

(h) The purposes specified herein shall be construed both as purposes and powers and shall be in no wise limited or restricted by reference to or inference from, the terms of any other clause in this or any other article, but the purposes and powers specified in each of the clauses herein shall be regarded as independent purposes and powers, and the enumeration of specific purposes and powers shall not be construed to limit or restrict in any manner the meaning of general terms or of the general powers of the corporation; not shall the expression of one thing be deemed to exclude another, although it be of like nature not expressed.


