Certificate of Organization of a Corporation Under the General Law

The undersigned, officers of a corporation organized at Augusta, Maine
at a meeting of the signers of the articles of agreement therefor, duly called and held at
177 State Street in the City of Augusta, Maine
on Wednesday the Twenty-fourth day of May A. D. 19
hereby certify as follows:

The name of said corporation is DAYSTROM-WESTON, INCORPORATED

The purposes of said corporation are

To design, manufacture, develop, buy, sell, assemble, import, export, lease, handle, install, erect, repair, refinish, renovate, service, distribute, and otherwise generally deal in and with, at wholesale and retail and as principal, agent, licensor, licensee, lessor, lessee, factor, on commission, or in any other lawful capacity any and all kinds of electrical and electronic components, appliances, equipment, accessories, assemblies, sub-systems, systems, indicators and instruments, and all other kinds of mechanical and electrical machines, machinery, devices, and appliances and all kinds of materials, supplies, accessories, equipment, devices, apparatus, products, or other things used in the manufacture, production, installation, erection, repair, servicing, distribution, handling, marketing, use, or operation of any of the foregoing, or in any other way thereto relating; and to engage generally in a general merchandising and trading business.

To acquire by purchase, exchange, lease or otherwise and to own, hold, use, develop, operate, sell, assign, lease, transfer, convey, exchange, mortgage, pledge or otherwise dispose of or deal in and with, real and personal property of every class or description and rights and privileges therein wheresoever situate.

To apply for, register, obtain, purchase, lease, take licenses in respect of or otherwise acquire, and to hold, own, use, operate, develop, enjoy, turn to account, grant licenses and immunities in respect of, manufacture under and to introduce, sell, assign, mortgage, pledge or otherwise dispose of, and, in any manner deal with and contract with reference to:

(a) inventions, devices, formulas, processes and any improvements and modifications thereof;

(b) letters patent, patent rights, patented processes, copyrights, designs and similar rights, trade-marks, trade symbols and other indications of origin and ownership granted by or recognized under the laws of the United States or America or of any state or subdivision thereof, or of any foreign country or subdivision thereof, and all rights connected therewith or appertaining thereto;

(c) franchises, licenses, grants and concessions
