

## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

## SUN COUNTRY SHOOTING PRESERVE, INC.

We, the undersigned, natural persons of the age of twentyone or more, acting as incorporators of a corporation, under the
Idaho Business Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of
Incorporation for such corporation.

FIRST: The name of the corporation is: Sun Country Shooting Preserve, Inc.

SECOND: The period of its duration is perpetual.

THIRD: The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

- (a) To provide the general public with a hunting preserve.
- (b) To build or otherwise acquire, to operate, and to lease, mortgage, sell, or otherwise dispose of equipment of every kind and character whatsoever, or other interests in connection, therewith.
