- 2. Article 1 Enter the name of the corporation. Pursuant to Idaho Code § 30-1-401, a corporate name must contain the word corporation, incorporated, company or limited, or an abbreviation thereof, provided however, that if the word "company" or its abbreviation is used it shall not be immediately preceded by the word "and" or by an abbreviation or symbol thereof. A corporate name must be distinguishable upon the records of the Secretary of State from any other formally organized entity, such as corporations, limited liability companies, limited partnerships and limited liability partnerships.
