

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
SEVENTH DAY ADVENTIST CHURCH
OF
CALDWELL, IDAHO.**

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of incorporating under the laws of the State of Idaho a religious corporation, to be known as "SEVENTH DAY ADVENTIST CHURCH OF CALDWELL, IDAHO", and we certify that the objects for which this corporation is formed are:

To establish a church in the City of Caldwell, County of Canyon, State of Idaho, and in connection therewith suitable and customary organizations for the purpose of public worship and religious training according to the rules and discipline of the Seventh Day Adventist Church;

To take charge of the real property of said organization and to have charge of all the estate and property and the affairs of the temporalities thereof.

That the principal place of business of this corporation shall be in the City of Caldwell, County of Canyon, and State of Idaho.

That the term of incorporation shall be fifty (50) years.

That the number of directors who shall have the management of its affairs as aforesaid shall be seven (7), and the names and places of residence of the directors elected for the first year are:

That said directors were duly elected at a meeting of the members of the Seventh Day Adventist Church aforesaid, duly convened and held in the Seventh Day Adventist Church in the City of Caldwell, Canyon County, Idaho, on the 28th day of December, 1921, for the purpose of electing directors to take charge of the management of its property, temporalities and affairs, and to form its corporation; that a majority of the members of such association who were present at such meeting voted at such election for the above named directors, as is more particularly set forth in the certificate and verification by the officers who conducted the election, hereto annexed and made a part of these articles.

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, That at a meeting of the members of Seventh Day Adventist Church of Caldwell, Idaho, duly convened for the purpose hereinafter set forth, held in the Seventh Day Adventist Church in the City of Caldwell, Canyon County, Idaho, on the 28th day of December, 1921, a majority of the members of such association who were present at such meeting voted at said election. R. W. Airey presided over the meeting as chairman thereof, and Herbert Gillis acted as secretary of said meeting;
