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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF
MOUNTAIN RIVER SNO-RIDERS, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS; that we, the undersigned, being natural persons of full age and Citizens of the United States of America, in order to form a non-profit cooperative association for the purposes hereinafter stated, pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify as follows:

ARTICLE I.

The name of the corporation shall be MOUNTAIN RIVER SNO-RIDERS, INC.

ARTICLE II.

The purposes for which said Corporation is formed are:

- A. To encourage and to promote lawful, careful, and considerate snowmobile operation and use for recreation and business pursuits.
- B. To promote knowledge on the part of members and the general public of the safe handling and proper care of snowmobiles and their use.
- C. To educate members and citizens in the care and respect of property, real and personal, owned by the members, the general citizenry, and governmental units.
- D. To forward the development of those characteristics of honesty and good fellowship, self-discipline, team play and self-reliance, which characteristics are the

essential elements of good fellowship and the foundation of true patriotism.

- E. To acquire and hold by purchase, gift, lease or otherwise, land and interests in land and improvements.
- F. To enter into any lawful arrangements for sharing of facilities, property or interests in the promotion of purposes of this Corporation.
- G. To have, exercise and enjoy all the powers now or hereinafter granted to Corporations organized under the Idaho Non-Profit Act, Chapter 3 of Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLE III

The Corporation is to have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE IV

The location and post office address of the Corporation's principal office shall be Post Office Box 50903, Idaho Falls, Idaho 83405.

ARTICLE V

The Corporation is not organized for a pecuniary profit. It shall not have any power to issue certificates of stock or to declare any dividends, and no part of its earnings shall inure to the benefit of any member, director, officer or individual. The balance, if any, of all money received by the Corporation from its operations, after payment in full of all debts and obligations of the Corporation, shall be used and distributed exclusively for charitable, scientific and/or educational purposes.

ARTICLE VI

The Corporation shall have only one class of members and each

member shall have issued to him or her a membership certificate, which certificates cannot be assigned so that the transferee thereof can by such transfer become a member of the association, except by resolution of the board of directors and under such regulations as are prescribed in the By-Laws.

ARTICLE VII

The voting rights of the members shall be equal, the interest and property rights of each member are equal, and no member can have or acquire a greater interest herein than any other member.

ARTICLE VIII

Conditions and regulations of membership and the rights and privileges of membership shall be determined and fixed by the By-Laws.

ARTICLE IX

The private property of the members shall not be liable for the Corporation's debts and obligations.

ARTICLE X

The Board of Directors shall consist of 3 directors, but during their term of office, or thereafter, the number of directors may be increased or decreased from time to time as provided in the By-Laws; provided, that the number of directors shall never be less than three (3) nor more than eleven (11). Qualifications and regulations of directors and rules and regulations pertaining to the Board of Directors shall be determined and fixed by the By-Laws.
