#### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

TOTEM AGENCIES, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That we, the undersigned, being natural persons all of legal age and citizens of the United States of America, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves for the purpose of forming a corporation for profit under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby certify:

#### ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation is TOTEM AGENCIES, INC.

#### ARTICLE II

The period of existence and the duration of the life of this corporation shall be perpetual.

#### ARTICLE III

The purposes and objects for which this corporation is formed are as follows:

- 1. To conduct a general business of buying, selling, and otherwise dealing in surety, bail and other indemnity bonds or obligations of whatsoever kind or nature, insurance of all kinds, including but not limited to, fire, casualty, life, accident, health, burglary, marine, credit, fidelity, and business-interruption insurance.
- 2. To conduct a general business of managing, buying, selling, or otherwise dealing in real property, including the promotion, platting, and subdivision thereof; and in the purchase, sale, and hypothecation of stocks, bonds, notes and all other forms of securities, bills of exchange and choses in action; and to act as trustee in deeds of trust, mortgages, or other security instruments affecting real, personal, or mixed property.
- 3. To conduct and engage in the general business of builders and contractors for the construction, alteration, repair, or remodeling of structures, public and private, of every kind and nature whatsoever; to promote, create, plat, subdivide, and build real estate subdivisions or projects, including construction of streets, roads, avenues, sewers, bridges, wells, walls, water systems, or other items pertinent thereto; and to perform engineering and architectural services, including the preparation of plans and specifications for its own projects, or as consulting engineers and architects.
- 4. To build, buy, equip, sell, construct, erect, option, lease, sublease, assign, mortgage, encumber, or otherwise deal in all works, contrivances, appliances, mills, fabricators, machinery, and properties of this or other corporations, or of private individuals, as may be either useful, expedient, or necessary in carrying out the foregoing purposes; and, generally, to enter into

all contracts and to do all acts in any way designed to aid in or 1 to carry out any or all of the objects and purposes set forth in 2 this Article. 5. To borrow money and otherwise incur indebtedness, 3 without limit as to the amount; and to draw, make, accept, endorse, transfer, assign, guarantee, execute, and issue such bonds, debentures, notes, checks, drafts, bills of exchange, and other instruments, negotiable and non-negotiable, secured and unsecured, 5 as may be necessary, customary, or appropriate in the conduct of such business. 6 To conduct business in this state or other states, 7 the District of Columbia, and the territories of the United States and in foreign countries or territories; and to maintain one or 8 more offices or other places of business inside or outside this state; and to receive, purchase, hold, acquire, mortgage, assign, transfer, lease, release, convey, and otherwise deal in and with any real or personal property, or any interest therein, within or without the State of Idaho, reasonably calculated to promote the purposes hereinabove stated for this corporation; and to do all 10 11 other things, including the creation, organization, and operation of such subsidiary corporations as may be necessary or convenient to the carrying into effect of the main purposes and objects of the organization of this corporation. 13 7. To purchase, insofar as the same may be done without impairing the capital of this corporation, except as otherwise 14 prohibited by law, and to hold, pledge, and reissue shares of its own capital stock; but such stock so acquired and held shall not 15 be entitled to vote nor to receive dividends. 16 8. To carry on any of the foregoing or closely related 17 businesses as principals, agents, lessors, lessees, assignors, assignees, franchisors, franchisees, licensors, licensees, or 18 otherwise, which can be generally carried on in connection with any of the pursuits aforesaid. 19 9. It is hereby expressly provided that the enumeration 20 hereinabove of the specific objects and powers shall not be narrowly construed and shall not be held to limit or restrict 21 in any manner the general powers of this corporation. 22 ARTICLE IV 23 The capital stock of this corporation shall be divided into 500 shares of nonassessable common stock of no par value. 24 ARTICLE V 25 The principal place of business of this corporation shall 26 be 1301 South Capitol Boulevard, City of Boise, County of Ada, State of Idaho, which is hereby designated as the address of its 27 registered office. 28 ARTICLE VI The names and post office addresses of the incorporators 29 and the number of shares subscribed by each are: 30 31

## ARTICLE XI

The fiscal year shall begin on the 31st day of January of each year.

#### ARTICLE XII

No contract, act, or other transaction between this corporation and any other corporation, whether or not a majority of the shares of the capital stock of such other corporation is owned by this corporation, shall in any way be affected or invalidated by the fact that any of the directors of this corporation are financially or otherwise interested in or are directors or officers

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of such other corporation; and any director, individually, or any firm of which such director may be a member, may be a party to or may be financially or otherwise interested in, any contract or transaction of this corporation; provided, that the fact that he or such firm is so interested shall be disclosed or shall have been known to the Board of Directors of this corporation, or to a majority thereof on the date of such contract or transaction; and any director of this corporation who is also a director or officer of such other corporation, or who is so interested, may be counted in determining the existence of a quorum at any meeting of the Board of Directors of this corporation which shall authorize such contract, act, or transaction, and may vote thereat to authorize such contract, act, or transaction with like force and effect as if he were not such director or officer of such other corporation, or was not otherwise interested therein.
