The petition of the Board of Directors of Western Dryer, Inc., praying for a decree of voluntary dissolution of said corporation coming before the Court pursuant to notice on the 18th day of February, 1968, and it appearing to the court that due and proper notice of hearing was given in the manner required by law and no one appearing in opposition to said petition and the petitioners appearing by and through their attorneys Elam, Burke, Jeppesen & Evans and by Ronald Yanko, an officer of said corporation, and the testimony of witnesses having been heard from which the Court finds:

That all claims and demands against Western Dryer, Inc., have been paid, satisfied and discharged and that there are now no outstanding debts and accounts against said corporation. And the Court finds further that at meetings of the Board of Directors and stockholders of Western Dryer, Inc., held on the 6th day of October, 1965, the dissolution of Western Dryer, Inc., was resolved upon and approved by more than a two-thirds vote of all stockholders of the corporation and the Court being now fully advised in the premises;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Western Dryer, Inc., a general business corporation be, and the same is hereby dissolved and each of the members of the Board of

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Directors of said corporation is hereby discharged and relieved
from all the obligations and duties of such office.
