ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

INLAND EMPIRE PLAYLAND, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned James A. Parker, Paul J. McElroy, Margaret Jean McElroy and Dwight Strong, being natural persons of full age, citizens of the United States and residents of the State of Idaho, in order to form a corporation for the purposes herein stated, pursuant to Chapter 1 of Title 30 of the Idaho Code, do hereby certify as follows:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be Inland Empire Playland, Inc.

ARTICLE II

The purposes for which said corporation is formed are:

To purchase, own, lease, operate and manage skating rinks, bowling alleys, golf driving ranges, and any and all forms of lawful recreational pursuit or undertaking.

To engage in or to promote any activity that will be a benefit to the athletic or leisure time needs of the area in which this corporation is formed.

To purchase outright, lease or otherwise acquire property, real, personal and mixed, of every nature and location, both within and without the State of Idaho, and to hold, operate, develop, improve, lease, exchange, trade in, deal with, sell and alienate the same, in whole or in part, as freely and fully as any natural person may lawfully do.

To borrow money and contract indebtedness, and to evidence the indebtedness of the company by notes, bonds or other instruments, and to secure the same by pledge, mortgage, trust, deed or such other encumbrances upon its property as to the company may seem proper; to loan money and take any form of security for the payment of the same and to hold, operate, sell, encumber or otherwise deal with such property as may be taken in security for or in payment of debts owing to the corporation.

To acquire and operate the business and goodwill of any other person or persons, firms and corporations transacting such business as this company may lawfully transact.

To acquire and own the stock, bonds and securities of other corporations and, while owning the same, to exercise all the privileges of ownership consistent with the corporation character of this company and to acquire the stock, common or preferred, of this corporation, insofar as the same is not prohibited by the laws of the State of Idaho.

To make and perform contracts of every kind with any person, firm, association or corporation.

To do any and all things convenient and incidental to the purposes herein expressed and generally to have and exercise all such powers as are by law conferred on corporations of like character and, without in any particular limiting any of the objects or purposes or powers of the corporation, the business and purposes of the corporation shall be from time to time to do any one or more, or all, of the acts and things herein set forth and all such other acts, things and business in any manner connected therewith directly or indirectly to promote the interests of the corporation or enhance the value of any of its property as such corporation may lawfully do; and, in carrying on its business or for the purpose of attaining any of its objects, to do any and all things and exercise any and all other powers not prohibited by law and, either as or by and through principals, agents, attorneys, trustees, contractors, factors, lessees or otherwise either alone or in connection with others.

ARTICLE III

The corporation is to have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE IV

The location and post office address of the registered office of the corporation is Moscow, Latah County, Idaho.

ARTICLE V

The amount of the total authorized capital stock of this corporation is Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$350,000) divided into thirty-five

thousand (35,000) shares of the same common class, of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) par value each.

ARTICLE VI

The names and post office address of the incorporators and the number of shares subscribed by each are as follows:

The incorporators shall serve as directors and shall manage and control the affairs of the corporation until the first meeting of shareholders for the adoption of bylaws and the completion of the organization.

ARTICLE VII

The number of directors shall be not less than four (4) nor more than fifteen (15) and the number, qualifications and terms of office, manner of election, time, place and manner of calling meetings and powers and duties of the directors shall be prescribed by the bylaws.

ARTICLE VIII

The officers of this corporation shall consist of a President, Vice-President, Secretary and a Treasurer, and such other officers as the Board of Directors of the corporation shall deem necessary, all of whom shall be shareholders who shall be elected by the Board of Directors and hold office during the pleasure of the Board. The Board of Directors in its discretion may elect the same person to the offices of secretary and treasurer. Each of the officers shall have such powers as may be conferred upon him by the bylaws of the corporation.
