tive Associations, as provided in Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLE OF INCORPORATION
OF
WESTERN CHAPTER, AFFILIATED BLIND OF IDAHO, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that we, the undersigned, being natural persons of full age, citizens of the United States and residents of the State of Idaho, this day have voluntarily associated ourselves for the purpose of forming a non-profit cooperative association under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho and we hereby certify as follows:

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of this corporation shall be WESTERN CHAPTER, AFFILIATED BLIND OF IDAHO, INC.

ARTICLE II

NOT FOR PROFIT

This corporation shall be a non-profit cooperative association and shall not be operated for the pecuniary gain of its members.

ARTICLE III

DURATION

The period of existence of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IV

PURPOSE

The objects and purposes of this corporation are:

1. To advance the vocational, economic, industrial and social status of the blind citizens of Idaho.
2. To purchase, acquire, own, hold, lease (either as lessor or as lessee), sell, exchange, subdivide, mortgage and generally operate any real or personal property of any and every kind or description, within or without the State of Idaho, necessary, suitable or useful in connection with any of the objects or purposes herein set forth.
3. To construct and erect buildings or structures upon and to improve and maintain any and all real property owned, leased or held by this corporation; and to equip, improve and generally operate any and all personal property owned by this corporation.
4. To receive donations and to receive, manage, take and hold real and personal property by gift, grant, devise or bequest.

ARTICLE V

STOCK

This corporation shall have no capital stock.

ARTICLE VI

REGISTERED OFFICE

The principal place of business and registered office of this corporation shall be Boise, Idaho.

ARTICLE VII

DIRECTORS

The management and control of this corporation shall be vested in a Board of Directors of said organization, which shall number not less than five, nor more than thirty-five members, as may be provided by the By-Laws of the corporation.

ARTICLE VIII

OFFICERS

The officers shall be elected by the Board of Directors, and their duties and powers shall be such as are vested in them by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE IX

MEMBERSHIP

The Board of Directors may establish and set up as many types of membership in this corporation as they may at any annual meeting decide upon. Evidence of membership in this organization may be shown by such means as the Board of Directors hereof may decide from year to year. The rights and interests of all members shall be equal and no member can have or acquire greater interest than any other member.

ARTICLE X

BY-LAWS

This corporation, acting through its Board of Directors, may adopt such By-Laws as they may deem expedient or necessary for the conduct of this corporation's business, and to carry out its purposes. Such By-Laws may be amended by a majority vote of the Board of Directors at any regularly called meeting or by a majority of those present at any annual meeting of the corporation.

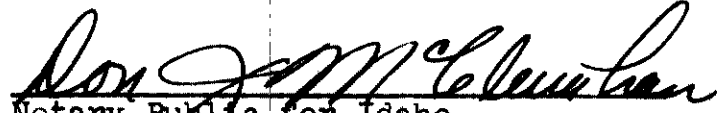
