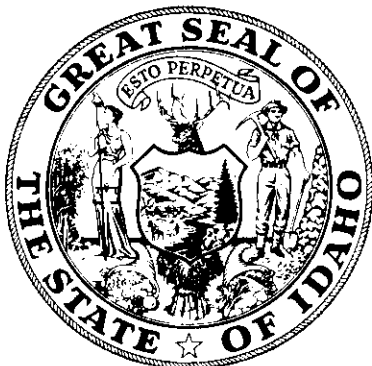

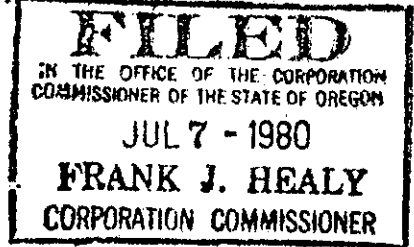

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

We, the undersigned natural persons of the age of twenty-one (21) years or more, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the Oregon Business Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation.

ARTICLE I.




