**Article 2: Purpose for which the corporation is organized**

Said organization is organized exclusively to own, operate, maintain and manage a water collection, storage and distribution system. This system would provide water for the mutual and beneficial use of the owners or occupants of lots 15-23 of the Copenhaver Subdivision and provide water for fire suppression, domestic use and irrigation. It qualifies as an exempt organization under section 501 ( c ) (12) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

**Article 8: Dissolution of the corporation**

Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 ( c ) (12) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code applying to like organizations.
