If the Idaho Business Corporation Act is amended to authorize corporate action further elimination or limiting the personal liability of directors, then the liability of a director of this corporation shall be eliminated or limited to the fullest extent permitted by Idaho Business Corporation Act, as so amended. Any repeal or modification of this Twelfth Article by the shareholders of the corporation shall not adversely affect any right or protection of a director of the corporation existing at the time of such repeal or modification.
