

Articles of Incorporation of the  
Union Congregational Church of  
Pearl, Boise County, Idaho. Duplicate.

First- This Corporation shall be known as "The Union Congregational Church of Pearl, Boise County, Idaho."

Second- The purpose of this Corporation is to carry forward the preaching and teaching of the Gospel of Jesus Christ, and the promotion of such enterprises as will best serve that purpose.

Third- The place where its worship and teaching is to be done is in Pearl, Boise County, Idaho.

Fourth- The estimated value of the property held at this time is Five Hundred Dollars.

Fifth- This Corporation shall exist for a period of Fifty years.

Sixth- There shall be a board of not less than three trustees elected annually as provided in by laws of this Corporation.

The following persons are in office as trustees at the time of this incorporation and were elected June 4<sup>th</sup> 1903.  
viz:- Henry King, A. Foulis, and  
Thos. L. Grimes, all of Pearl Idaho.

A majority of the members of the Church  
were present and voted at the meeting  
which was held at Pearl Lake, at the  
time the aforesaid trustees were elected.  
The Rev J. H. Singleton, Presiding.  
Sworn to- The title of the person making  
these articles is that of Pastor, and is  
now at the time of making these articles  
Pastor of the Church hereby incorporated.
