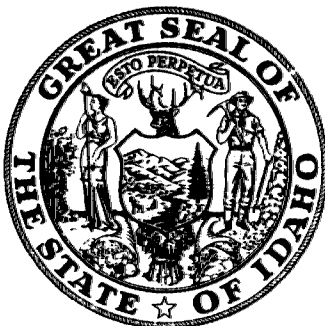

# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

S.A.M.U.E.L. , INCORPORATED

(Society of American Missions Uniting and Equipping Laborers)

I, the undersigned, Stuart W. Peterson, an individual, hereby subscribe to the following Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation in the State of Idaho, of which corporation, I am the registered agent.

## ARTICLE I.

The name of the corporation shall be S.A.M.U.E.L. (Society of American Missions Uniting and Equipping Laborers), Incorporated.

## ARTICLE II.

The period of duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

## ARTICLE III.

Said corporation is organized exclusively for religious purposes, being the ownership and operation of a Christian Missionary Society and Church which will be open to public membership.

## ARTICLE IV.

The corporation will not distribute surplus funds to any person who participated in the formation of the corporation, or to any person serving on the Board of Elders, or who is otherwise connected with said corporation.

## ARTICLE V.

Should the corporation dissolve, the Board of Elders shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation,

dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Elders shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Superior Court of the County in which the principle office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

#### **ARTICLE VI.**

The address of the initial registered office of the corporation shall be 435 West Park Avenue, Kellogg, Idaho 83837. The mailing address of the corporation shall be Post Office Box 485, Kellogg, Idaho 83837.

#### **ARTICLE VII.**

The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors (also called Board of Elders) is three and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as the initial directors are as follows:
