ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT

Pursuant to Section 30-147 of the Idaho Code, the Twin Falls Reformed Church, Inc., adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation:

I.

The name of the corporation is the Twin Falls Reformed Church, Inc.

II.

The following amendment of the Articles of Incorporation was adopted by the members of the corporation on the 22nd day of January, 1978, in the manner prescribed by the law of the State of Idaho and the Articles of Incorporation of the Twin Falls Reformed Church, Inc. Publication has been made as required by law and a copy attached hereto.

ARTICLE VI A

The members of this corporation have no property rights in the assets of the corporation, and upon the termination of the membership they shall be entitled to no interest in the assets and property of the church. In the event of the termination and dissolution of the corporation, the assets and property of the corporation shall be vested in the classis of which the church is a member, Reformed Church in America.

III.

The amendment added a new article to be known as Article VI A which set out the property right of the members of the church.

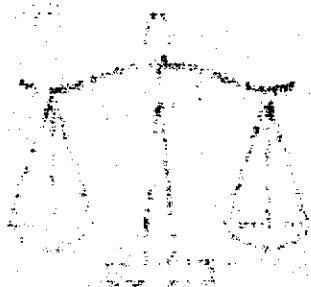
