KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the Undersigned, members of a subsidiary of the American Legion, a benevolent and patriotic society federally chartered and incorporated under Title 36, United States Code, Chapter 217, Section 21701 et seq. in accordance with the rules of said society and under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Idaho, incorporate ourselves and form an Idaho Non-Profit Corporation as follow, to wit:

ARTICLE 1: The name of the corporation is DUDLEY LOOMIS POST NO. 6, THE AMERICAN LEGION, INC.

ARTICLE 2: The Purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

- A. To uphold and defend the Constitution of the United States; to maintain law and order; to foster and perpetuate a one hundred percent Americanism; to preserve the memories and incidents of our association in all wars; to inculcate a sense of individual obligation to the community, state and nation; to combat the autocracy of both the classes and the masses; to make right the master of might; to promote peace and goodwill on earth; to safeguard and transmit to posterity the principles of justice, freedom and democracy; to consecrate and sanctify our comradeship by our devotion to mutual helpfulness.
- B. To buy, sell, hold, acquire, own, mortgage, hypothecate, convey, transfer, lease, manage, improve, trade, and dispose of real and personal property; to borrow money and to secure the same by obligations, pledges, deeds of trust or mortgages; to give and receive donations of real and personal property by gift grant, devise or bequeath; to create trusts for benevolent or other purposes.
- C. To promote, conduct, provide for, maintain, and carry on any and all kinds of activities for the entertainment, diversion, and recreation of the members hereof.
- D. To lend money and render benevolent aid and comfort.
- E. To engage in other activities, as in the opinion of the Executive Committee, may further any of the foregoing purposes and powers and do all things necessary and proper in carrying out the corporation's purposes.
- F. To constitute a tax-exempt Veterans organization pursuant to Section 501(c)(19) of the United States Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE 3: The corporation's Registered Agent is Rand Lewis, 317 S. Howard St, Moscow, Idaho, 83843.

ARTICLE 4: The business of the corporation shall be conducted by the Post Executive Committee consisting of five (5) members who shall be the ex-officio Board of Directors of the corporation. Further, the initial Board of Directors who were duly elected for the year 1928 on the 23d day of February 1928 were:

ARTICLE 5. The initial Incorporators were the persons listed in Article 4 herein.

ARTICLE 6. The Mailing Address of the Corporation is P.O. Box 8195, Moscow, Idaho 83843.

ARTICLE 7: There is no capital stock and no shares of stock, and pecuniary profit is not the object of the corporation. The corporation has voting members.

ARTICLE 8. Upon dissolution of the corporation, the assets thereof shall be distributed to the Idaho Department of the American Legion, Inc. Idaho Corporation No. 81907
