

Certificate of Incorporation of the  
"Bellevue and Bradford, Railway,  
Passenger and Freight Transportation  
Company."

A Corporation formed under the  
provision of a law passed at the Thir-  
teenth Session of the Legislative Assembly  
of the Territory of Idaho. And granting  
to George L. Medelund, Richard Hambley,  
Levy Young, James Cummings and  
Edward J. Curtis, the right to construct  
build and maintain a street railway  
from the City of Bellevue to the town  
of Bradford, and through the streets  
of said City and town in the County  
of Alturas Territory of Idaho. Approved  
February 5th 1885.

Article 1. The Corporate name of  
this Corporation is and shall <sup>be</sup> the  
Bellevue, and Bradford, Railway  
Passenger and Freight Transportation  
Company.

Article 2: The principal place of  
business of said Corporation is intended  
to be within Alturas County, in Idaho  
Territory, and the main office of said  
Corporation shall be in the City of  
Bellevue in said County.

Article 3: The objects for which said Corporation is intended, and formed, are to construct, build and maintain a Street Railway, for the purpose of transporting ~~carriage~~, and conveying passengers, and freight to and from the City of Bellevue, and the town of Broadford, and through the streets of said City and town, and to and from the Railway Depot near the City of Bellevue or within the limits of the City of Bellevue, in the said County of Ottawa, Idaho Territory, and to operate the said road by horse power, or by steam power as they shall <sup>deem</sup> best, - and for the purpose of extending the said road, and operate the same by steam, or horse power to the town of Healy - in said Ottawa County, and Territory aforesaid:

Article 4: The amount of the Capital Stock of this Corporation is and shall be the sum of One hundred thousand dollars and the same shall be divided into One hundred thousand shares of One dollar each:

Article 5: This Corporation shall continue for the period of Fifty years, from the date of the approval of the Legislative Charter to wit: the Fifth (5) day of February A. D. 1885:

Article 6: There shall be a board of directors of this Corporation of the number of five persons, who shall manage the concerns of the Company for the period of six months from the Fifth day of February A.D. 1885. and thereafter the board of directors shall be elected annually.

The names of the first board of directors and their residences are as follows.

Geo L Medekin, Richard Hambley, Levi Young, James Cummings, of the County of Atturas, and Edward J Curtis, of the County of Ada, all of the Territory of Idaho.
