

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF YOLANDA MINING COMPANY.

I, L. Magee, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that the undersigned,
H.W. Morse, Thomas L. Greenough, Joseph Carson, W.H. Myers and
F.H. Renshaw, hereby associate themselves together for the purpose
of forming a corporation under the provisions of the laws of the
State of Idaho, and for such purposes state,

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That the name of the corporation shall be "The Yolande Mining Company."

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That the purpose for which this corporation is formed is for mining and operating mines and mining claims within said State of Idaho, and particularly within said Shoshone County in said State. Also for the purpose of buying, selling, locating, bonding, contracting for, leasing and operating mines and mining claims together with the necessary appliances connected therewith for the purpose of working, operating and developing mining claims; the purchase, lease, construction, owning, operating and controlling tram-ways, electric plants and power, water-power, machinery, mills, smelters, concentrators, power plants, electric lines, water rights and ditches and each and every thing incident and necessary to the ownership, enjoyment and use of the aforementioned special enterprise.

And said corporation is especially authorized to subscribe for, purchase, own, sell or dispose of the stock in any other mining corporation, and to exercise any and all rights pertaining to the ownership of such stock.

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The principal place of business of the corporation shall be at Wallace, County of Shoshone, State of Idaho.

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The term for which the said corporation shall exist is fifty (50) years.


