ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of the

MOSCOW FARMERS STORE.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That, we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho;

AND WE HEREBY CERTIFY,

First. That the name of this corporation shall be;
MOSCOW FARMERS STORE.

Second. That the objects and purpose for which this corporation is formed shall be, to do any and all things herein set forth as fully and to the same extent as natural persons might or could do in all things herein provided for as follows;

- a. To acquire, build, purchase, lease, own, occupy and use lands and buildings, necessary or essential for the carrying on of the business of the corporation, and to acquire any other lands or property, real, personal or mixed as security for the payment of any debt or debts due or owing to the corporation.
- b. To carry on the business of merchandising in the buying and selling groceries, light hardware, foot wear, clothing, farm machinery and such other goods, wares and merchandise as may be determined by the company, for the conducting of the business of general merchandising, and to purchase, sell and deal in such

goods, wares and merchandise, as are usual in a general store; and to do all other things subsidiary, necessary or convenient for carrying out and into effect the main purposes and objects of the organization of the corporation.

c. To make, execute and deliver, under the direction of the Board of Directors of this corporation, evidences of indebtedness, for money borrowed and for such other purposes as may be required in the conduct of the business, and secure the same by the pledge or lien upon the property of the corporation, and to take and receive bills of exchange, promissory notes, contracts, mortgages or other evidence of claims and debts due or owing to the corporation, and to do and perform generally each and every act and thing necessary to be done with reference to the financial part of the business.

Third. That the place where its principal business is to be transacted, shall be at Moscow, Latah County, State of Idaho, but that meetings of the Board of Directors, may be held at such other place or places as may be designated by resolution by the Board of Directors.

Fourth. That the term for which this corporation is to exist is fifty years from and after the date of its incorporation.

Fifth. That the number of Directors of this corporation, shall be five and that the names and residences of those who have been selected to serve as such directors until the first regular meeting of the stockholders are:-

and that all directors of this corporation shall hold their offices until their successors are elected and qualified.

Sixth. That the amount of the capital stock of this corporation authorized, shall be Twenty Five Thousand (\$25,000.00) Dollars, which shall be divided into Two Hundred and Fifty (250) shares, and that the par value of each share shall be One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars.

Seventh. That the amount of capital stock which has been actually subscribed is the sum of Nine Thousand and Four Hundred Dollars, and the following are the names of the persons by whom the same has been subscribed, and the amount and number of shares taken under such subscription, to-wit:

Eighth. That this corporation shall have the power to do any

and all things necessary, suitable and proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes or for the attainment of any of the objects or for the exercise of any of the powers herein set forth, whether herein specified or not, either alone or in connection with other firms, individuals or corporations, either in this state or throughout the United States, and elsewhere, and to do any other act or acts, thing or things incidental or pertinent to or connected with the business hereinbefore described, or any part of parts thereof, if not inconsistent with the laws under which this corporation is organized.

Nineth. That all of the stock of this corporation issued or to be issued, shall be common stock.
