ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

JOHNSON'S NEWS AGENCY, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, being natural persons of full age and citizens of the United States, in order to form a corporation for the purposes hereinafter stated, pursuant to the Business Corporation Act of Idaho, do hereby certify as follows:

ARTICLE I.

The name of the corporation is JOHNSON'S NEWS AGENCY, INC.

ARTICLE II.

The purposes for which said corporation is formed are:

1. To conduct and carry on the business of buying, selling, and dealing in and with books of any and all kinds, whether new or old and periodicals, newspapers, advertisement material, pictures, sound reproductions, films, publications, printed material and reproductions of all kinds, manuscripts, prints, engravings, lithographs, pamphlets, writings, publications, stationery, and similar goods or merchandise; to conduct the business of an agency in all of its branches for any and all of said goods or merchandise; to acquire and carry on a selling agency or agencies for the sale of any and all merchandise pertaining or relating to books, manuscripts, prints, engravings, lithographs, pamphlets, writings, and similar goods or merchandise; to deal in and with goods, wares, and merchandise and personal property of every and any sort, nature, or description;
2. To appoint such officers, employees and agents as the business of the corporation may require and to allow them compensation;
3. To enter into contracts or obligations of any type of kind essential, necessary or proper to the transaction of its ordinary affairs, or for the purposes of the corporation;

4. To do all and everything necessary, suitable, and proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes of the attainment of any of the objects or the furtherance of any of the powers hereinbefore set forth, either alone or in association with other corporations, firms, clubs, or individuals, and to do every other act or acts, thing or things incidental or appurtenant to or growing out of or connected with the aforesaid objects or purposes or any part or parts thereof, provided the same be not inconsistent with the laws under which this corporation is organized.

5. To engage in any commercial enterprise calculated or designed to be profitable to said corporation and in conformity with the laws of the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE III.

The purposes specified herein shall be construed both as purposes and powers and shall be in no wise limited or restricted by reference to, or inference from, the terms of any other clause in this or any other article, but the purposes and powers specified in each of the clauses herein shall be regarded as independent purposes and powers, and the enumeration of specific purposes and powers shall not be construed to limit or restrict in any manner the meaning of general terms or of the general powers of the corporation; nor shall the expression of one thing be deemed to exclude another, although it be of like nature not expressed.

ARTICLE IV.

The commencement of the life of this corporation shall be the date of the issuance to it of a Certificate of Incorporation by the Secretary of State of Idaho, and the duration of the life of this corporation shall be fifty years.

ARTICLE V.

The location and post office address of the registered office of the corporation is 223 Home Street
City of Moscow , County of Latah , State of Idaho .

ARTICLE VI.

The total authorized number of par value shares is twenty-five thousand (25,000). The aggregate par value of the total authorized number of par value shares is twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00), i.e., one dollar (\$1.00) per share.

ARTICLE VII.

The stock of the corporation is divided into twenty-five thousand (25,000) shares of common stock. No other stock or type of shares shall be issued and said share conveyed to the owners thereof.

ARTICLE VIII.
