

The undersigned, in order to form a Non-Profit Corporation under the provisions of Title 30, Chapter 3, 7007 MAY 24 All 80 St. submits the following articles of incorporation to the Secretary of State.

AKTICLE I. NAME.

ARTICLE II. NONPROFIT STATUS

The Corporation is a nonprofit corporation.

The purposes for which the Corporation is organized and will be operated are as follows:

- To exercise all powers granted by law necessary and proper to carry out the above-stated C. purposes, including but not limited to the power to accept donations of money, property, whether real or personal, or any other thing of value. Nothing herein contained shall be deemed to authorize or permit the Corporation to carry on any business for profit, to exercise any power, or to do any act that corporation formed under the Act, or any amendment thereto or substitute therefor, may not at that time lawfully carry on or do.

ARTICLE III. INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT
