ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

BUNNEVILLE DAY CARE TRAINING CENTER, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, being of legal age and being residents of the State of Idaho and citizens of the United States of America, do hereby, as incorporators thereof, form a non-profit cooperative association under the laws of the State of Idaho, according to and in compliance with Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code, and we do hereby adopt Articles of Incorporation as follows:

ARTICLE 1.

The name of this corporation shall be the BONNEVILLE DAY CARL TRAINING CENTER, INC.

ARTICLE II. Purpose

The purposes for which said corporation is formed are as tollows:

- 1. To provide training for mentally retarded children.
- 2. To establish, maintain and operate facilities for the training of mentally retarded children.
- 3. To establish, maintain and operate a sheltered worksnop for mentally retarded children.
- 4. To assist parents in providing training for mentally retarded children.
- 5. To sponsor and support research and study in the field of mental retardation.
- 6. To encourage and assist in the establishment, expansion and improvement of programs in the public schools for mentally retarded children who are educable or trainable.
- 7. To promote greater public knowledge and understanding of mental retardation and to encourage wider public acceptance of mentally retarded children and adults into community life, including recreation and social programs.
- 8. To receive by gift, bequest, devise or otherwise and to purchase, convey, mortgage and lease all kinds of real and personal property.

- 9. To borrow money, and to draw, make, accept, endorse, assign, guarantee, execute and issue notes, checks, drafts, bonds, debentures, negotiable instruments and all other instruments for the payment of money and to mortgage or pledge its property to secure such obligations.
- lu. To have, exercise and enjoy all powers now or hereafter granted to corporations organized under the laws of the State of Idano, and particularly all the powers and privileges granted to corporations under Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code, and in present and future amendments thereto, and to engage in any other activity and to do any act or other thing necessary to carry into effect the aforementioned purposes.
- 11. To exercise and perform all of the above described powers both within and without the State of Idaho

ARTICLE III. Principal Place of Business

This corporation shall have its principal place of business in the City of Idaho Falls, County of Bonneville, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE IV. Duration

The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE V. Nembers

inis corporation is organized without capital stock and the rights and interests of all the members shall be equal. The qualifications for members shall be provided in the By-Laws.
