CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

NEVADA STREET CHURCH OF CHRIST, GOODING, IDAHO, INC.

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Twenty-fifth** day of **March,** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty-three** and is duly recorded on Film No. **123** of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 30-103, 30-1101 and 30-1102, Idaho Code.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Gooding** in the County of **Gooding** and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
NEVADA STREET CHURCH OF CHRIST, GOODING, IDAHO, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, all of whom are natural persons of full age and citizens of the United States of America, and associated together as members of the Church of Christ, of which pecuniary gain or profit is not an object, in accordance with the rules, regulations and discipline of such organization, and for the purpose of forming a religious corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, do now, on this 15th day of March, in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Nine Hundred Sixty-three, hereby voluntarily associate ourselves, and do hereby make and execute the following Articles of Incorporation, and do certify as follows:

ARTICLE 1. NAME. The name of this corporation shall be NEVADA STREET CHURCH OF CHRIST, GOODING, IDAHO, INC.

ARTICLE 2. PURPOSES. The general purposes of this corporation shall be to maintain and propogate the Christian religion, in accordance with the written Word of God as set forth in the HOLY BIBLE. The particular purposes of this corporation shall be to administer the temporal affairs of the Nevada Street Church of Christ, Gooding, Idaho, Inc. at the City of Gooding, Idaho; to establish and maintain a place or places of worship and teaching, for meetings of said church; to buy, sell, hold, build, lease or rent a church building or buildings, and to furnish and maintain the same; to acquire or receive title to real and personal property, by purchase, devise, gift, grant or other conveyance, and to mortgage, sell, convey or otherwise dispose of its property, or any part or portion thereof, whether real or personal; and to do all things incident and pertinent to such purposes, or usual for such church or society. Pecuniary gain or profit shall not be an object of this corporation.

ARTICLE 3. DURATION. The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE 4. LOCATION AND POST OFFICE ADDRESS. The location and post-office address of the registered office of this corporation shall be Gooding, Idaho.

ARTICLE 5. MEMBERS. The members of this corporation shall consist of those persons who now are, or who shall become, members of the Church of Christ of Gooding, Idaho, provided, that any person who shall for any reason cease to be a member of said Church shall thereupon, ipso facto, cease to be a member of this corporation; and provided further, that no Modernist, or advocate of or believer in so-called Modernism, no Pre-millennist, no teacher of anti-literature or anti-class teaching, no anti-orphan home advocate, no anti-corporation advocate, and/or one cup theorist shall become, be, or remain a member of this corporation; nor shall any such person control, enjoy, manage, occupy or use, or possess any interest, right or title in any property of this corporation, real or personal.

ARTICLE 6. DIRECTORS. The government of this corporation, the management of its business and property, and the management of the temporal affairs of said Church shall be vested in a board of five (5) directors, who shall be selected from the membership of the corporation and shall be persons of business experience and recognized character, and shall attend to the affairs of the corporation of said Church with promptness and accuracy. Of the first Board of Directors, one shall be elected for a term of one year, one for a term of two years, one for a term of three years, one for a term of four years, and one for a term of five years, and, in each case, until his successor has been elected and has qualified. At the regular annual meeting of the members of the corporation in the year 1963, and thereafter at each succeeding annual meeting of said members, one director shall be elected for a term of five (5) years and until his successor has been elected and has qualified.

ARTICLE 7. OFFICERS. The officers of this corporation shall be a President, a Secretary, and a Treasurer, who shall be chosen by

the directors from among their own number at the first meeting of the first board of directors, and thereafter at the first meeting of the directors following each annual meeting of members of the corporation. Said officers shall serve as such for a term of one year from and after their election, and except as otherwise provided in the by-laws hereafter to be adopted, shall respectively perform the duties customarily performed by such officers.

ARTICLE 8. CAPITAL STOCK. This corporation shall have no capital stock nor shares of stock.

ARTICLE 9. BY-LAWS. The said directors may, by unanimous vote, adopt such by-laws, not contrary to the laws of the State of Idaho, nor inconsistent with these Articles, as may be deemed necessary for the proper government of this corporation and the management of the business and property thereof, and may by a like vote, alter or amend the same, and, when so adopted, such by-laws, and all amendments thereof, shall before they can take effect, be signed by each of said directors and be recorded by the secretary in a book to be provided and kept for that purpose.

ARTICLE 10. USE OF INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC. No mechanical instruments of music shall be permitted or used on any premises owned by this corporation for any religious purpose.

ARTICLE 11. CERTIFICATE OF ELECTION OF DIRECTORS. That a duly called meeting of the members of this corporation was held at the church building of the Nevada Street Church of Christ, Gooding, Idaho, in Gooding, Gooding County, Idaho, which said church building is the place where said members regularly meet for public worship and the transaction of business, on Friday the 15th day of March, 1963, at the hour of eight o'clock P.M., at which meeting a majority of the members who were present voted for the election of directors; that due and regular notice of the time and place of holding such meeting and election was given by publication for at least two weeks in the Gooding Leader, a weekly ^{newspaper/}published and of general circulation in Gooding, County of Gooding, State of Idaho, the city where said

election was held, and was published in said paper on ~~March~~ ^{FEBRUARY} 28, 1963 and also on March 7, 1963, and also by posting a like notice in a conspicuous place on the building where said election was held, which remained posted at all times from ~~March~~ ^{FEBRUARY} 26, 1963, until the date of said election.

That at said meeting the following members were duly elected directors of this corporation for the following terms: Claude Lewis, who shall hold his respective office until the first annual meeting of the members of the corporation in 1964, A. J. Hendrix, who shall hold his respective office until the second annual meeting of the members of the corporation in 1965; Doyle Johnson, who shall hold his respective office until the third annual meeting of the members of the corporation in 1966; Keith Amende, who shall hold his respective office until the fourth annual meeting of the members of the corporation in 1967; and J. H. Johnson, who shall hold his respective office until the fifth annual meeting of the members of the corporation in 1968.

ARTICLE 12. INCORPORATORS. That the names of all of the incorporators of this corporation and the post office address of each are as follows:

ARTICLE 13. AUTHORIZATION TO INCORPORATE GRANTED. That at said meeting, these Articles of Incorporation were by unanimous vote duly adopted and said persons so elected as Directors were duly authorized to execute and file the same for record, and to duly incorporate this association for and in behalf of its members.
