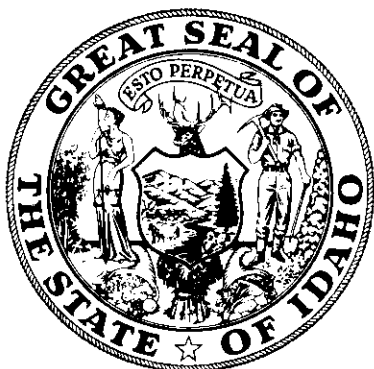

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
THE IDAHO ASSOCIATION FOR PASTORAL CARE, *Inc.*

KNOW ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS COME, these are the Articles of Incorporation of the Idaho Association for Pastoral Care.

FIRST: The name of this corporation shall be:

The Idaho Association for Pastoral Care, *Inc.*

SECOND: The Idaho Association for Pastoral Care is a non-profit corporation. It is not formed for pecuniary profit and no part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that this corporation is empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the Third Article of these Articles. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propoganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or any corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

THIRD: The purpose of the Association shall be to:

- a. Promote pastoral care and counseling;
- b. Provide opportunities for continuing education;
- c. Provide consultation and support services to members of the Association, to the community, to churches and other religious institutions, and to others requesting the same.

FOURTH: The duration of the Association is perpetual.

FIFTH: The location of the office of said corporation at the time of incorporation is Boise, in Ada County, Idaho.

SIXTH: The location and mailing address of the initial registered office of the corporation shall be: 190 E. Bannock, Boise, Idaho, 83702. The name of its initial registered agent is: Robert H. Rhinehart, President.

EIGHTH: This is a membership corporation. The qualifications for membership in the Association shall be set forth in the By Laws of the corporation. The Association is authorized to issue certificates, cards or other instruments evidencing membership rights.

NINTH: The private property af any member of the corporation shall not be subject to the payment of corporate debts to any extent whatsoever, and the membership certificates, if such, shall not be subject to assessment for any purpose of paying expenses, conducting business or paying debts of the corporation.


TENTH: The number of the directors of the Association shall be nine (9), who shall be elected in the manner specified in the Bylaws of the corporation.

ELEVENTH: Amendments to the Articles of Incorporation may be made as provided by law. The board of directors shall adopt a resolution setting forth the proposed amendment and directing that it be submitted to a vote at a meeting of the members having voting rights. The amendment(s) may be made at an annual meeting or any special. Notice of the proposed amendment shall be given to each member entitled to vote as provided for by the laws of Idaho. The proposed amendment shall be adopted upon receiving a majority of the votes which members present in person or by proxy are entitled to cast.

TWELFTH: Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Trustees shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by law, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization as the court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
