THE UNDERSIGNED, acting as incorporator of a corporation under the Idaho Business Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

FIRST

The name of the corporation is SMOKE GUARD CORPORATION.

The period of its duration is perpetual.
