CERTIFICATE OF ORGANIZATION OF A CORPORATION UNDER THE GENERAL LAW.

The undersigned, officers of a corporation organized at Augusta, Maine, at a meeting of the signers of the articles of agreement thereto, duly called and held at office of Heath & Andrews in the City of Augusta, on Saturday the Seventh day of June A. D. 1908, hereby certify as follows:

The name of said corporation is Western Mining and Developing Company.

The purposes of said corporation are First: To purchase, acquire, own, hold, operate, rent, locate, improve, use, work, develop, lease, mortgage, sell, convey and dispose of mines and mining claims of every description and kind, ditches, flumes, water and water rights, and other water and riparian rights which shall deemed necessary or convenient for its business, mills, concentrators, smelters, reduction works, electric light and power plants, lands, town and city lots, and any and all property incident or necessary for the uses and purposes of this corporation, wherever permitted by law.

Second: To conduct a general mining, milling, smelting and reduction business.

Third: To purchase, secure, use, own and enjoy any and all franchises useful and beneficial for the prosecution of the business of this corporation.

Fourth: To exercise the right of eminent domain outside of the State of Maine, where permitted by the laws of such jurisdiction, and under the same limitation to condemn and acquire rights of way for tunnels, shafts, washing works, dams, cuts, flumes, ditches, canals, reservoirs, storage basins, dams, roads, railways, and tramways incident, necessary or convenient for the uses, purposes and objects of this corporation and do all things incident to the general business of this corporation in any of the states or territories composing the United States of America, or in Canada, Mexico, or elsewhere that this corporation may desire and conduct to the business, if not prohibited by the laws of such state or country.

Fifth: To buy and sell ores, bullion, metals and minerals and concentrates and all other materials and supplies, and to reduce ores and minerals for pay.

Sixth: To borrow moneys on its notes, bonds and other obligations for the general purposes of the corporation, and to mortgage, pledge, and give in trust any and all of its property, real and personal, to secure the payment thereof.

Seventh: To do and perform all other matters and things that may be found necessary or convenient to carry out the objects of this corporation.

Eighth: To acquire, purchase, hold and sell stock in other corporations.

The amount of capital stock is Two Hundred and Fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000)

The amount of common stock is Two Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000)

The amount of preferred stock is nothing.

The amount of capital stock already paid in is nothing.
