
ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF THE
TAYLOR AND GOSHEN CANAL COMPANY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purposes of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho; and we hereby certify: First. That the name of said corporation is The Taylor and Goshen Canal Company.

Second. That the purpose for which it is formed is to construct and own canals and acquire water rights, and to take water for agricultural purposes and for domestic use, the head of its main canal located at the tail race of the water wheel of the town of Idaho ~~on the Crow and Watts Slough in the town of Idaho Falls~~ Falls, Bingham County, Idaho, and running thence in a southerly and southeasterly direction to Cedar Hollow which shall be the terminus.

Third. The place where its principal business is to be transacted shall be the town of Taylor Bingham County, Idaho.

Fourth. That the term for which it is to exist is fifty years from and after the date of its incorporation.

Fifth. The number of its directors shall be five and the names and residences of those appointed for the first year or until their successors shall be elected by the stockholders on the 22 day of March 1899, are as follows, to-wit:-
