
THE YEE CO., INC.,





ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
THE YEE CO., INC.



We, the undersigned natural persons of the age of twenty-one years or more, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the Utah Business Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is

THE YEE CO., INC.

SECOND: The period of its duration is one hundred years.

THIRD: The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

To wreck, demolish and otherwise tear down, salvage and remove, in any manner whatsoever, any and all types of improvements, buildings, structures, automobiles and any and all other property and things of whatsoever kind and character, real, personal or mixed, and to buy and sell salvageable and reclaimed materials of all kinds, character and description; to excavate, construct, enlarge or otherwise engage in any work upon unimproved and improved land; to engage in the business of hauling of property and things of whatsoever kind and character, real, personal or mixed.

To buy, sell, rebuild, reconstruct, recondition, alter, repair, or otherwise deal in and with all kinds of machinery, equipment, fixtures, supplies and appliances, new or used, and used metals, rags, cloth, paper and all other kinds of scrap and junk.

In general, to carry on any other lawful business whatsoever in connection with the foregoing or which is calculated, directly or indirectly, to promote the interest of the corporation or to enhance the value of its properties.

FOURTH: The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is:

Thirty Thousand Shares (30,000) of the par value of Twenty-Cents (\$0.20) each.

FIFTH: The corporation shall not commence business until at least one thousand dollars has been received by it as consideration for the issuance of shares.

SIXTH: Provisions limiting or denying to shareholders the preemptive right to acquire additional or treasury shares of the corporation are:

There shall be no preemptive rights.

SEVENTH: Provisions for the regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation are:

None.

EIGHTH: The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 7545 South 2700 East, Salt Lake City, Utah, and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is Edward B. Erickson.

NINTH: The number of directors constituting the initial board of directors of the corporation is five, and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as directors until the first annual meeting of shareholders or until their successors are elected and shall qualify are:
