I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

IDAHO RETAILERS ASSOCIATION, INC.

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the Ninth day of September A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred Sixty, and is duly recorded on Film No. 112 of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 30-103 and Sections 30-1001 to 30-1005, inclusive, Idaho Code.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for

perpetual existence from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at Boise, in the County of Ada,

and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Non-Profit Cooperative Associations as provided in Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

IDAHO RETAILERS ASSOCIATION, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned, all being citizens of the United States, of legal age, this day having voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Edaho, do hereby certify:

ARTICLE I.

Name

The name of the corporation shall be "IDAHO RETAILERS ASSOCIATION, INC."

ARTICLE II.

Location

The location of the principal office of the Association shall be any place designated by the Board of Directors. The registered office of the Association shall be Boise, Ada County, Idaho, and its term of existence shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III.

Purposes

The purposes and objectives of the Idaho Retailers Association shall be purely benevolent and educational and shall not be for pecuniary gain or profit. These purposes and objectives are as follows:

- (a) To conduct a service program in behalf of the retail industry of Idaho.
- (b) To promote unified action by all segments of the retail industry in matters that are of common interest, to the end that retailers may better serve the public.
- (c) To provide non-partisan and non-political representation to all brokers of retailing -- independent and chain, small and large.
 - (d) To cooperate with other state and national groups

and with non-retail groups, such as educational organizations, farm organizations, chambers of commerce, on matters of common interest that affect the conduct of retailing; and on programs that strengthen and develop the state's agricultural and industrial economy.

- (e) To serve as a factfirding bureau to collect, analyze and interpret all available data related to retail distribution, and to translate these facts to Idaho retailers and other organizations; and to cooperate with both the Legislative and Executive branches of the State and Federal Government to the end that retailers may better serve the public.
- (f) To do other acts that may tend to benefit the retail industry as well as producers and consumers of goods, wares and merchandise.

ARTICLE IV.

Membership

The association shall be conducted as a non-profit, cooperative association, without capital stock, sustained by the payment by each member of an annual membership fee, which shall be
fixed as directed by the By-Laws and as nearly as practicable at
the cost of services rendered or made available to members.

Any person, firm, corporation or association, possessing such qualifications as may be prescribed by the By-Laws, may become a member upon admission by the Board of Directors. The rights and interests of all members shall be equal. A membership may be transferred or assigned only to a qualified person (other than a member) upon consent by resolution of the Board of Directors and under such regulations as may be prescribed by the By-Laws.
