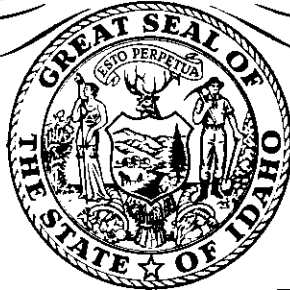

# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

-of-

ENGBLOM BROS., INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, all being of full age, and all citizens of the United States of America, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Business Corporation Act of the State of Idaho, and to that end we hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I. The name of the corporation shall be ENGBLOM BROS., INC..

ARTICLE II. The purpose of the corporation is to engage in a general contracting business, including, but not limited to the following, to-wit:

- (a) Construction, repair and remodeling of all types of buildings;
- (b) Moving of houses and other buildings;
- (c) Excavating and dirt-moving; and,
- (d) Concrete and masonry work.

To acquire, sell, or encumber such properties, real or personal, as may be necessary to carry on any of the above described businesses.

To do all things necessary and incidental for the operation of said businesses.

ARTICLE III. The period of existence and the duration of the life of the corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IV. The principal place of business shall be Bonner County, Idaho; the post office address of its registered office shall be Priest River, Idaho.

ARTICLE V. The stock of the corporation is divided into 100 shares of common stock at \$100.00 par value each.

ARTICLE VI. The total authorized number of par value shares is 100. The aggregate par value of the total authorized number of par value shares is \$10,000.00.
