I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

EASTERN IDAHO ANKUS ASSOCIATION, INC.

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Fourteenth** day of **August**, A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty-four** and is duly recorded on Film No. **129** of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 30-103 and Sections 30-1001 to 30-1005, inclusive, Idaho Code.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Sugar City** in the County of **Madison** and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Non-Profit Cooperative Associations as provided in Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION
OF
EASTERN IDAHO ANGUS ASSOCIATION, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, being natural persons of legal age and citizens of the United States, do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit co-operative association under Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code, and do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation, to-wit:

ARTICLE I.

The name of said association shall be EASTERN IDAHO ANGUS ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE II.

That the term of existence of said association shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III.

That the location and post office address of its registered office in this state shall be Sugar City, Madison County, Idaho.

ARTICLE IV.

The purpose for which this association is formed is to promote herd improvement programs, 4-H projects and to aid, assist, and encourage the raising, improving, exhibiting, selling, and developing of Aberdeen Angus Cattle, particularly in the eastern section of the State of Idaho, for the buying, selling, holding, leasing, and controlling of such property as may be necessary and incidental to such purpose. The corporation shall be non political and shall engage in no business for pecuniary profit.

ARTICLE V.

The rights and interests of all members shall be equal, and no member can have or acquire a greater interest therein than any other member.

ARTICLE VI.

The association shall not issue any capital stock but shall issue a membership certificate to each member thereof. Any citizen of the United States and any corporation or association mentioned in Section 30-1003, Idaho Code, may become a member of this association under such rules and regulations as the Board of Directors of this association may from time to time establish. Certificates of membership shall be issued to each member of this association, which certificate cannot be conveyed so that any transferee can by such transfer become a member except by resolution of the Board of Directors and under such regulations as the By-Laws may prescribe.

ARTICLE VII.

That the names and residences of the persons chosen to be the first directors of this association to manage and conduct the business and affairs thereof for the first year are as follows:


