That I, the undersigned, being of legal age and a citizen of the United States, do this day voluntarily form a corporation under the provisions of the Idaho Business Corporation Act, and certify in writing:

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be A. R. SYSTEMS, INC.

ARTICLE II PURPOSE AND POWERS

The initial registered office and physical location of the corporation in the State of Idaho shall be 401 2nd Street North, Suite 201, Twin Falls, Idaho 83301. Brit D. Groom, whose mailing address is Post Office Box 1901, Twin Falls, Idaho 83303-1901, shall be the initial registered agent of the corporation.

ARTICLE V CORPORATE STOCK
