**CERTIFICATE OF AMENDMENT  
OF ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF THE CHURCH OF THE OPEN  
DOOR OF BETHLEHEM, INCORPORATED**

A duly and regularly called meeting of the members of the corporation was held on November 17, 1967 at 8 p.m. at the Chapel of the Open Door of Bethlehem, for the purpose of changing the name of the corporation, "Church of the Open Door of the Christian and Missionary Alliance" of Boise, and amending the articles of incorporation by adding thereto. The following action was taken, and is respectfully certified to be true:

- (1) That the Board of Directors be authorized to do and perform all and every act and thing necessary, expedient and convenient to be done in amending the present articles of incorporation of the Church of the Open Door of the Christian and Missionary Alliance of Boise, and to add thereto the name of the Chapel of the Open Door.
- (2) Be it therefore resolved, that the name of the church be changed to, "The Open Door Chapel of the Christian and Missionary Alliance of Boise, Idaho" and that the same shall remain the name of the Open Door Chapel of the Open Door Corporation, hereinafter.
- (3) RESOLVED that a resolution of incorporation of the Open Door Chapel of the Open Door, Incorporated, be adopted as follows:

Article I

The name of this corporation is the Chapel of the Open Door of the Christian and Missionary Alliance of Boise, Incorporated.
