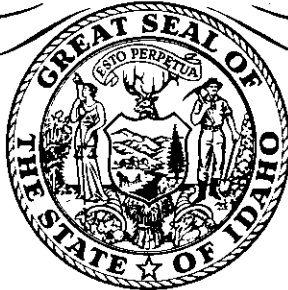

(3) RESOLVED That the Articles of Incorporation of the Church of the Open Door of DaiSS, Incorporated be amended to read as follows:
