ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION RURAL MINISTRY RESOURCES, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation for religious and educational purposes pursuant to Title 30, Chapter 11 of the Idaho Code and do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

I.

The name of the corporation shall be RURAL MINISTRY RESOURCES, INC.

II.

The corporation is formed for the purposes of support, training, education and other appropriate ministry to church leaders in rural settings and other church leaders who have a concern for church leadership in rural and small town areas of the Pacific Northwest. The corporation shall be operated exclusively as a non-profit organization for religious, charitable, and educational purposes pursuant to sections 170(c)(2) and 501(c)(3) of the United States Internal Revenue Code. All property now held or which may be acquired by gift, purchase or otherwise, and the proceeds therefrom, and any net earnings of the corporation, shall be used exclusively for religious, charitable or educational purposes, and no part of said property or earnings shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to any member, director or private person. The corporation shall not engage in political propaganda, attempt to influence legislation, or participate in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. So far as is consistent with these restrictions, the corporation is empowered to engage in any lawful activity the directors deem to be in furtherance of the purposes herein set forth.

III.

The principal place of business of the corporation shall be the University of Idaho Campus Christian Center, 822 $\rm Elm$ Street, Moscow, Idaho 83843.

IV.

The corporation shall have perpetual existence.

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The corporation is authorized to determine by by-law the number of members and qualifications for membership and the number, manner of election, and term of directors, and other matters of internal organization, and to amend the same in the manner prescribed by said by-laws; provided, that in no event shall the number of directors be less than three (3) nor more than one hundred (100).
