KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That the undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Idaho Corporation Act, Title 30, Chapter 1, Idaho Code, does hereby certify, declare the following Articles of Incorporation:

I

The name of the Corporation shall be PULLOVER PRINTS CORPORATION.

II.

The nature of the business, or the object or purpose to be transacted, promoted, or carried on by the Corporation, is:

- (1) To apply screen printed and embroidered corporate and athletic logos on apparel and other business and athletic items; and
- (2) To transact any other lawful business for which a corporation may be incorporated under the Idaho Business Corporation Act.

III.

The aggregate number of shares which the Corporation shall have the authority to issue is one hundred thousand (100,000) shares of no-par value common stock. Said shares shall be of one class only.

IV.

The Corporation is to have a perpetual existence.

V.

The business of the Corporation shall be managed by its Board of Directors, each of whom shall be at least eighteen (18) years of age. The number of directors of the Corporation shall be set forth in the Bylaws in a manner not prohibited by law. Until so changed, the number of directors shall be at least one (1), but not more than ten (10). The directors need be neither stockholders of the Corporation, nor residents of the state of Idaho.

The names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as directors until the first annual meeting of the shareholders, or until their successors are elected and qualified, are as follows:

## VI.

The private property of the stockholders shall not be subject to the payment of the corporate debts.

## VII.

The Corporation shall have the authority, in accordance with Idaho State law, to indemnify each director or officer, or any person who may have served at its request as a director or officer of another corporation in which it has shares of capital stock or of which it is a creditor, against expenses actually and necessarily incurred by him in connection with the defense of any action, suit, or proceeding in which he is made a party by reason of being or having been a director or officer of the Corporation or of such other corporation (whether or not he continues to be a director or officer at the time of incurring expenses) except in relationship to matters as to which he shall be adjudged in such action, suit, or proceeding to be liable for negligence or willful misconduct in the performance of his duty as a director or officer. Such indemnification shall not be deemed exclusive of any other rights to which those indemnified may be entitled under any Bylaw, agreement, vote of stockholders, or otherwise.

The Corporation shall have the right to defend and to incur reasonable expenses in the defense of any such actions, suits, or proceedings brought against such director, officer, or person. Wherever in this section a director or officer is referred to, such reference shall include his or her personal representatives, executors, and administrators.

## VIII.

Meetings of the stockholders may be held outside the state of Idaho if the Bylaws so provide. Subject to any provision contained in any statute, the books of the Corporation may be kept outside the state of Idaho at such place or places as may be designated from time to time either by the Board of Directors or in the Bylaws of the Corporation. Election of directors need not be by ballot unless the Bylaws of the Corporation shall so provide.

## IX.

The Corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change, or repeal any provision herein contained in the manner now or hereafter prescribed by statute and all rights conferred upon stockholder herein are granted subject to this reservation.





