I, IRA H. MASTERS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

**MOUNTAIN HOME LODGE NO. 19, INCORPORATED, INDEPENDENT ORDER OF
ODD FELLOWS, OF MOUNTAIN HOME, IDAHO.**

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **14th** day
of **August** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Fifty-three** and
is duly recorded on Film No. **81** of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho,
and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 30-103, 30-1101
and 30-1102, Idaho Code.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates
and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for
Fifty (50) Years from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located
at **Mountain Home** in the County of **Elmore**,
and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service
Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30,
Idaho Code.

" ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION "

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned, all bona fide residents of this state, do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation according to and under the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby certify:

I.

That the name of this corporation is MOUNTAIN HOME LODGE No. 19, Incorporated, Independent Order of Odd Fellows, of Mountain Home, Idaho.

II.

That the purposes for which this corporation is formed are to lease, purchase, receive, hold, sell, convey, and mortgage such real or personal property as such lodge or corporation may acquire, own or use for the purposes of carrying out the social, charitable, benevolent and other purposes of such corporation or lodge, according to the constitution, by-laws, rules and regulations of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows, and the laws of the State of Idaho. To borrow money, to be evidenced by promissory notes, bonds or other lawful obligations, either secured or unsecured, by the hypothecation of any or all of its real, personal or mixed property, and to that end to enter into such lawful contracts as may be necessary to raise money to build or complete a building, to be occupied in whole or in part, as a hall to be used for the purposes of said lodge. To pay any debt existing against said lodge, before its incorporation, or any debt it may hereafter contract, in furtherance of the purposes for which it is incorporated, and the objects and purposes of said Order.

III.

That the place where its principal business is to be transacted is the city of Mountain Home, County of Elmore, and State of Idaho.

IV.

That the time for which this corporation is to exist is fifty (50) years, from and after the date of its incorporation.

V.

V.

The number of its Trustees shall be three (3).

VI.

This corporation is a membership corporation, and has no capital stock, and is not organized for pecuniary profit.

VII.

That on the 9th day of July, 1953, at the lodge room of Mountain Home Lodge #19, I.O.O.F., in the city of Mountain Home, County of Blaine, State of Idaho, an election was held for the purpose of electing Trustees, at which time and place a majority of the members of said lodge who were present voted, and said election resulted in the election of the following persons to serve as Trustees, to-wit:

Mr. Otto C. Fisher, of Mountain Home, Idaho, to serve as a Trustee, until Dec. 31, 1953.

Mr. Bhurl Hamilton, of Mountain Home, Idaho, to serve as a Trustee, until Dec. 31, 1954.

Mr. Ed. Markham, of Mountain Home, Idaho, to serve as a Trustee, until December 31, 1955.

That prior to the date of said election, notice of the time and place of holding such election was given by publication in The Mountain Home ~~Times~~ ^{NEWS}, a weekly newspaper published in Mountain Home, Idaho, in the county in which such corporation is located, for not less than two weeks immediately preceding the date for such election, and a like notice was posted in a conspicuous place on the building where the said election was held, for the same length of time.

VIII.

There shall be held annually a meeting of such corporation, the particular date of which shall be fixed by its by-laws, at which annual meeting there shall be elected one (1) Trustee, to serve for a term of three (3) years.
