ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
HouseWrights, Inc.

The undersigned, Terrence Duncan, being qualified as an incorporator of a corporation under the Idaho Business Corporate Act, of legal age, enters into these Articles for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and does hereby make, adopt, execute, and acknowledge these Articles of Incorporation as follows:

ARTICLE I: Corporate Name

The name of the corporation shall be HouseWrights, Inc.

ARTICLE II: Shares

The corporation shall have authority to issue 500,000 shares of common voting stock.

ARTICLE III: Initial Registered Office and Registered Agent

The initial registered office of the corporation shall be located at 429 Destiny Bay Road, Sagle, Idaho. The initial registered agent at the address shall be Terrence Duncan.

ARTICLE IV: Initial Board of Directors

The number of directors of this corporation shall be not less than one nor more than nine. The initial Board of Directors of this corporation shall consist of one board member, who shall be Terrence Duncan, whose address is 429 Destiny Bay Road, Sagle, Idaho, who shall be the initial chairperson of the Board of

The purpose for which this corporation is organized is the transaction of any and all lawful business.


ARTICLE VII: Cumulative Voting
