ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we the undersigned, all being of legal age, citizens of the United States of America, and residents of the State of Idaho, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho and we do hereby certify as follows:

I.

That the name of said corporation shall be Twin City Fuel, Inc.

II.

That the purposes for which said corporation is formed are:

(a) To purchase or otherwise acquire, sell and deal in, as principal or agent, on commission or otherwise, and at whole-sale or retail, coal and coal products, wood and wood products, oil, gasoline and all other kinds of fuel. To acquire and operate all kinds of fuel storage and transportation facilities and equipment and to engage in a general fuel supply and distributing business.

(b) To purchase or otherwise acquire, sell and deal in, as principal or agent, on commission or otherwise, and at whole-sale or retail, oil, gasoline and all petroleum products, automobile accessories of every nature, automobile parts and service, to acquire and operate all types of storage and transportation facilities and equipment for the foregoing products and services, and to generally engage in the automobile service station business.

(c) To purchase, lease or otherwise acquire, in whole or in part, the business, good will, rights, franchises and property of every kind, and to undertake the whole or any part of

the assets or liabilities, of any person, firm, association or corporation engaged in or authorized to conduct any business similar to any authorized to be conducted by this corporation, or owning property necessary or suitable for its purposes, and to pay for the same in cash, in the stock or bonds of this company, or otherwise; to hold or in any way dispose of the whole or any part of the business or property so acquired, and to exercise all the powers necessary or incidental to the conduct of such business.

(d) To borrow money, to issue bonds, debentures, notes and other obligations of this corporation from time to time, for any of the objects or purposes of this corporation, and to mortgage, pledge, hypothecate, and/or convey in trust, any or all of its property to secure the payment thereof.

(e) To enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts of every kind and for any lawful purpose, without limit as to amount, with any person, firm, association, corporation, municipality, state, or government, or any subdivision, district or department thereof.

(f) To acquire, and pay for in cash, shares of stock, bonds or notes of this corporation, or otherwise, the assets including the good will of any person, firm, association or corporation, and to undertake or assume the whole or any part of the obligations or liabilities thereof.

(g) To engage in and conduct any and all kinds of manufacturing businesses.

III.

That the location and post office address of the registered office of this corporation and the principal place of business of this corporation shall be in the City of Kellogg, County of Shoshone, State of Idaho.

IV.

That the term for which this corporation shall exist shall be perpetual.

The capital stock of this corporation shall be all of one class and in the amount of Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) Dollars divided in Fifty Thousand (50,000) shares of the par value of One (\$1.00) Dollar per share.


