ARTICLE I: NAME.

ARTICLE X: LIMITATION OF LIABILITY.

No director shall be liable to the Corporation or its stockholders for monetary damages for breach of fiduciary duties, except liability for: (A) the amount of financial benefit received by a director to which the director is not entitled; (B) an intentional

infliction of harm on the Corporation or the stockholders; (C) a violation of Idaho Code Section 30-1-833 (liability for unlawful distributions); or, (D) an intentional violation of criminal law.
