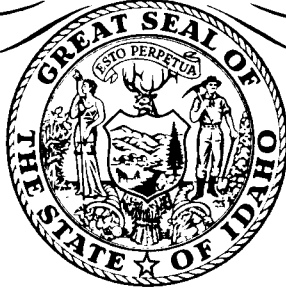

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

J. E. HALL CONTRACTORS, INC.

We, the undersigned, all being of legal age and citizens of these United States of America, and being natural citizens and subscribers to shares of stock of the corporation to be organized do, pursuant to the statutes of the State of Idaho, hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

I.

The name of the proposed corporation is

J. E. HALL CONTRACTORS, INC.

II.

The purpose for which this corporation is formed is to engage in logging and sawmill operations for the purpose of cutting, sawing, re-sawing, hauling, selling and marketing said lumber products.

That this Corporation shall have the power to own, acquire, purchase and lease both real and personal property, and shall be empowered to mortgage, pledge and hypothecate real and chattel property for the purposes of conducting the business operations hereof, and borrowing money therefor.

That said corporation shall have the right to sell, lease and convey real property.

That said corporation shall be empowered to engage in trucking, bulldozing and other related activities connected with logging, including the right to construct and build roads, buildings, operate quarries, sawmills, dry kilns and other related incidents to the operation of a sawmill or construction.

That said corporation shall be authorized and empowered to sell lumber products at wholesale or retail and to do all things necessary without limitation for the purpose of carrying out the operations and purposes of this corporation.

Said corporation shall be authorized to borrow money, pledge, hypothecate or mortgage assets of said corporation and to execute and deliver instruments necessary therefor. That said corporation shall have the power and right to enter into contracts and agreements for the purchase of logs, timber, standing timber and to do all things necessary and incident to the operation contemplated by said corporation for the purposes of carrying into effect the operation thereof.

III.

The name of the county and the city within the county of which the principal office of the corporation is to be located in the State of Idaho is Elk River, Clearwater County.

IV.

The existence of this corporation shall be perpetual.

V.

The number of directors of this corporation is three. The names and addresses of the incorporators for the first three months and until their successors are elected, are:

The amount of capital stock of the corporation is \$800,000. The stock of the corporation shall be divided into 8000 shares of common stock at \$100. Each share of common stock shall have equal voting power for the election of any director and in the affairs of the corporation as a stockholder thereof.
