That we, the undersigned, have this day associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho and for that purpose do hereby adopt these Articles of Incorporation.

Article I

PURPOSE: The purpose for which this corporation is organized is the transaction of any or all lawful business for which nonprofit corporations may be incorporated under the laws of the State of Idaho, as they may be amended from time to time.

Article IV

Character of affairs:

- 1) To worship God the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
- 2) To build up the Church of Jesus Christ through the teaching of the Scriptures and the ministry of the Holy Spirit.
- 3) To call men and women to believe the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- 4) To serve the local, national, and global community.
- 5) To facilitate and provide spiritual, social, and physical opportunity to the local and global community through scheduled events, activities, rescources and gatherings.

Article V MEMBERSHIP

This corporation does not have voting members.

Article VI

No part of the net earning of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to it's directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in article IV. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on: (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Laws) or: (b) by a corporation, contributions in the distributions of the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Laws) or: (b) by a corporation, contributions in the distributions of the corporation of any future United States Internal Revenue Laws) or: (b) by a corporation, contributions is all the corporation of the corpo

Upon dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of it's assets exclusively for the purpose of the corporation in such manner, or to such organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purpose as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Laws) as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the superior court of the County in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purpose or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purpose.

Article VIII

The power of indemnification under the Idaho Revised Statutes shall not be denied or limited by the bylaws.
