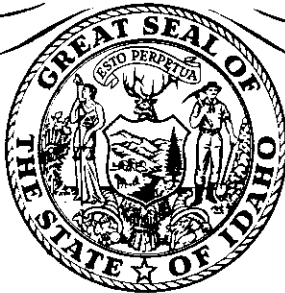

CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

SOUTHERN IDAHO MIGRANT MINISTRY, INC.,

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Second** day of **May** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty-one** and is duly recorded on Film No. **114** of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 30-103, 30-1101 and 30-1102, Idaho Code.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Boise,** in the County of **Ada,** and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
of
SOUTHERN IDAHO MIGRANT MINISTRY, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, do hereby certify that we have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the provisions of Chapter 11, Title 30, Idaho Code, in manner following, to-wit:

ARTICLE I

That the name of the corporation shall be "SOUTHERN IDAHO MIGRANT MINISTRY, INC."

ARTICLE II

That this corporation is one which does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to the members thereof.

ARTICLE III

That this corporation is formed to operate and maintain the Southern Idaho Migrant Ministry; to provide church and community activities for migratory people; to secure adequate interest and financial support; to present the program to the State at large; to correlate the work with the Migrant Ministry of the Division of Home Missions of the National Council of Churches; and to use the corporate name and title "Southern Idaho Migrant Ministry, Inc.;" to have perpetual existence as a legal entity even though the membership may change; to acquire, own, deal with, and dispose of property, both real and personal; to act through necessary officers and agents; to sue and be sued in the corporate name; and to make any provisions not inconsistent with the law or with the purposes of the corporation, or to do anything reasonably necessary or incidental for the conduct of its affairs.

ARTICLE IV

That the principal and registered office for the transaction of the business of this corporation is Boise, Ada County, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE V

That the names and addresses of the incorporators and directors elected by a majority of the associated members present at such meeting who voted at such election held pursuant to, and at the duly posted time and place specified in, the duly published notice, proof of publication of which notice is attached hereto, are:

Stanley E. Andrews, Boise, Idaho,
William F. Pinkerton, Boise, Idaho,
and Merle W. Wells, Boise, Idaho.

ARTICLE VI

That the authorized number and qualification of members of this corporation, the different classes of membership, if any, the voting and other rights and privileges of members shall be set forth in the by-laws hereafter to be adopted.

ARTICLE VII

That the management and title of all property of the corporation, real, personal and mixed, shall be under the control of the Board of Directors; that the promotion, operation and maintenance of the Southern Idaho Migrant Ministry, Inc., shall be under the control and supervision of said Board of Directors elected in the manner provided in the by-laws hereafter to be adopted.

ARTICLE VIII

The by-laws of this corporation shall be adopted by the Directors named in the Articles of Incorporation and may thereafter be repealed or amended by any means provided in the by-laws; that the election and the duties of the Board of Directors shall be specified in the by-laws; that the corporation shall exist perpetually hereafter.

ARTICLE IX

That upon dissolution, all assets of this corporation shall be and become the exclusive property of the National Council of Churches of Christ in the United States of America for the use of the National Migrant Ministry.
