

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of the

FAIRVIEW CEMETARY COMPANY, FAIRVIEW ONEIDA COUNTY, IDAHO.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:-

That we, the undersigned, a majority of whom are free holders, citizens and residents of the State of Idaho, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, AND WE HEREBY CERTIFY:-

FIRST-. That the name of the corporation shall be the FAIRVIEW CEMETARY COMPANY.

SECOND-. That the purposes for which it is formed are to have and to hold real and personal property; to care for and regulate the graves of the departed buried upon the lands held by said company; to decorate, regulate or otherwise care for the said graves or ornament the said graves as the company may desire from time to time and to do all other acts necessary to be done in order to fully care for and bury any of the dead.

THIRD-. The place where the principal business of said corporation is to be carried on shall be Fairview, Oneida County, Idaho.

FOURTH-. That the term for which said corporation is to exist shall be fifty years from and after its incorporation.

FIFTH-. That the number of Directors or Trustees of said corporation shall be THREE and the names and residences of the Directors or Trustees, who are appointed for the first year, a majority of the members being present and voting, and to serve until the election and qualification of such officers, are as follows, to-wit:-

SIXTH-. That on the 9th day of March, A. D. 1904, at the Fairview Meeting House, Oneida County, Idaho, at one o'clock p. m. of said day, at an election held for the purpose of naming three Trustees for the purpose of acting as Trustees of said corporation, a majority of all the share-holders in said Company being present at said election, the above named Trustees or Directors were unanimously elected the Trustees thereof. Edwin Bodily was the chairman of said meeting and Elijah Gilbert was the Secretary of said meeting.
