

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of the

FIRST CHRISTIAN CHURCH OF CALDWELL IDAHO.

Know All Men By These Presents: That the members of the Christian Church of Caldwell, Idaho, have voluntarily associated themselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho. And this is to certify:

First. That the name of this corporation shall be the First Christian Church of Caldwell, Idaho.

Second. That this corporation is organized for the purpose of maintaining religious worship, and of acquiring and owning such real and personal property as may be necessary for the objects of this association.

Third. That the place where its principal business shall be transacted is Caldwell, Idaho.

Fourth. That the term for which this corporation shall exist shall be fifty years from and after the date of its incorporation.

Fifth. That the number of its directors shall be three, and that the names and residences of those appointed ~~forst~~ Directors are;

Sixth. That there shall be no capital Stock.

Seventh. That the directors of this corporation shall hold office during life, or until their ~~offices~~ declared vacant and and their successors shall be elected.

Eighth. That the directors shall purchase such property, and make such contract~~s~~only, which shall be binding upon said association, as they may be directed to ~~par-~~
to do
~~chase and make~~ by the association; and such direction shall be given by vote at a meeting of the association, at which at least one-third of the members are present. And the directors shall have the general oversight and care of the property of the association.

Ninth. That a meeting was held to elect directors of said corporation at Caldwell, Idaho, on the fifth day of April, A. D. 1892; that a majority of the members of said association were present ~~at said meeting~~ and voted in said election, and the result of said election was the choice of said F. L. Keller, J. H. Merritt, and Jno. C. Rice as directors, as aforesaid.
