

Articles of Incorporation

of the Fall River Irrigation Company
A record kept by these members:

That we, the undersigned have this day
Voluntarily associated ourselves together
for the purpose of forming a corporation
under the laws of the State of Idaho.

First: That the names of said Corporation
is the Fall River Irrigation Company.

Second: That the purpose for which it is
formed are, to carry on and conduct
the Business of building Canals and
Ditches, for Irrigation, Domestic, and
Manufacturing purposes, also, for
the purpose of selling and purchasing
water. The said Canal is taken out of
that certain stream which is known
as Fall River, in the County of Brigham
and State of Idaho, at a point on the
south side of said River, in Section
Number Twenty (20) in Township number
Eight (8) North of Range Number
Forty Two (42) East of Boise Meridian,
and is Forty feet wide on top, and Thirty
five feet wide on the Bottom, and about
four feet deep, and running in a
southerly direction for a distance of about
seven miles: and that the Intermediate
branches are known as the South branch
is taken from the Main Canal at a point

In the North east quarter of Section Thirty, Township Eight, North of Range Forty two East, and running, in a Southwesterly Direction, through Sections viz: 6, 2, 10 to the North east Corner of Section No. 16, Township No. 7, North Range No. 4 East and the North Branch is taken from said Canal at a point on the North side, and is running in a Southwesterly direction for about four miles.

Third: That the capital stock shall be Ten Thousand Dollars, divided into Four hundred Shares of the par value of Twenty Five Dollars each.

Fourth: That the place where its principal business is to be transacted shall be in the Town of Wilford in the County of Bingham and State of Idaho.

Fifth: That the term for which it is to exist is Fifty years, from and after the Date of its Incorporation.

Sixth: That the number of its Directors or Trustees shall be five (5) and that the names and Residences of those who are appointed for the first year are,
