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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
CASCADE LOGGING CO., INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, all citizens of the United States of America, and citizens and bona fide residents of the State of Idaho, of legal age, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a general business corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and

WHEREFORE AGREE:

THAT

That the name of this corporation is:

CASCADE LOGGING CO., INC.

Article 1, Articles of Incorporation  
Cascade Logging Co., Inc.

Article 1

That the nature of the business and the objects and purposes to be transacted, promoted and carried on are to do any and all of the things herein mentioned as fully and to the same extent as any one person might or could do in any part of the world, viz:

(a) To purchase, lease, or otherwise acquire, for cash or on terms of credit, real estate in the state of Idaho or elsewhere; to erect thereon hotels, motels, inns, lodging facilities or other buildings and to sell, lease or otherwise dispose of same; to own, lease and operate in the state of Idaho and elsewhere one or more hotels, motels, inns, or general lodging businesses and all appurtenant accommodations and accessories thereto, including restaurants, theatres, saloons, bars, night clubs, soda fountains, barber shops, beauty salons, laundries, news and cigar stores, gift shops, florist shops, and general merchandise stores; and to provide swimming, bathing, tennis and other recreational, amusements and entertainment facilities to guests; to do and perform any and all things for the pleasure, comfort, convenience, amusement, and welfare of guests and patrons of said hotels, motels, and lodging facilities; and to plan, design and construct buildings for the servicing or similar purposes and to buy, sell, or otherwise acquire or dispose of same; and to operate, manage, conduct, or carry on such businesses in conjunction with or separate from the hotel and motel businesses.

(b) To purchase, own, hold and dispose of the stocks and bonds of this and other corporations, and particularly of corporations engaged in buying, selling and leasing, operating or managing real estate, hotels, motels, inns, and accommodations and facilities therefor.

(c) To purchase, improve, develop, lease, and lease, sell, dispose of, and otherwise deal in and turn to account, real estate; to purchase, lease, build, construct, erect, occupy, and manage buildings of every kind and character whatsoever; to finance the purchase, improvement, development, and construction of land and buildings belonging to or to be acquired by this corporation, or any other person, firm, or corporation.
